What is Wajima-nuri?

It is high-quality lacquerware characterized by a sturdy base made using diatomaceous earth produced in Wajima City and multiple layers of lacquer coating.



What is Kaga Yuzen?

It is a traditional dyeing technique used in kimono, characterized by intricate hand-painted patterns depicting nature.



What is Kutani ware?

It is a traditional ceramic ware from Ishikawa Prefecture, characterized by five colors: red, yellow, green, purple, and dark blue.



What is Yamanaka ware?

It is a traditional craft that has been practiced for 400 years in the Yamanaka Onsen area of Kaga City, Ishikawa Prefecture.

This lacquerware highlights the natural beauty of the wood grain.



What is Kanazawa gold leaf?

It is Kanazawa gold leaf, which accounts for 100% of the national production, and is characterized by its extremely thin, beautiful shine.



Food sample making experience (with a choice of Kutani ware small plate)

Considered one of Japan's subcultures, "food samples." You can experience making samples of representative Japanese food, "nigiri sushi." Comes with a plate of local "Kutani ware." For more details, please contact Yunokuni no Mori.
